STATEMENT REGARDING TSCA

As part of our commitment to supply environmentally-safe products throughout the world, PCB Piezotronics (PCB) supports the aim of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Toxic Substances Control Act. The EPA has issued a Restriction of five PBT's per section 6(h), Significant New Use Rules (SNUR) LC-PFAC per section 5(a)2, and PFAS Reporting section 8(a)7.

The EPA published restrictions on five substances DecaBDE (1163-19-5) Decabromodiphenyl ether; PCTP (133-49-3) Pentachlorothiophenol; PIP (3:1) (68937-41-7) Phenol, isopropylated, phosphate (3:1); 2,4,6-TTBP (732-26-3) 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol; and HCBDD (87-68-3) Hexachlorobutadiene. We declare that all our products to the best of our knowledge do not contain the substances listed. In addition, PCB does not have any products with LC-PFACs that are considered a Significant New Use.
